## **Dealing with Disruptions**

"There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens." Ecclesiastes 3:1

Last Wednesday night at the Covenant Bible Study we discussed the third chapter of the book of Ecclesiastes. It's an incredible chapter that reminds us that God's timing is always perfect. We also talked about how it's important to remember that truth because life sends plenty of things our way that we don't necessarily anticipate. Little did I know that my understanding of this passage would soon be put to the test.

Early Thursday morning as I headed down I-75 on my way to a funeral in Snellville, I had an unexpected visit from an old friend - Mr. Kidney Stone. Unfortunately, he showed up uninvited and immediately starting acting up so I was forced to turn around and head toward a hospital in Chattanooga. Without going into all of the details, in order to bid farewell to my stony little friend, I had to have an emergency outpatient procedure which landed me back at home on bed rest for 3-4 days.

Now you need to know that I'm not a very good patient. I can admit it. I do whatever my doctors tell me to do but I don't do well sitting on the sidelines resting. So as a result, I hate to say it but after a couple of days I started to have a little pity party. I wasn't very happy because my life had been interrupted without my permission. I hadn't planned to start the New Year with a trip to the hospital...blah, blah, whine, whine, whine. It was pathetic.

Well, while I was knee deep writing my own little sob story God reminded me of that passage from Ecclesiastes that our group had studied a few days earlier. It didn't take me long to get the point. I knew I needed to quit whining, trust God's timing, and look for what I could learn from what I was going through. In other words, it was time to practice what I preach.

God taught me several things through my disruption but honestly the most valuable lesson was about you...my church family. I knew that THUMC was full of loving and compassionate people. Time and time again, I have witnessed you reaching out and caring for those going through their own 'disruptions', but over the last week I experienced it firsthand.

I cannot begin to tell you how much your cards, calls, prayers, and food have meant to us. Thank you for your love and concern. But most of all, thank you for reminding me of how God comes alongside us in very real ways when life doesn't go as we plan.

No we don't always understand why things happen when they do, but we can always trust that God's timing is perfect. Some of His best lessons are taught during what we see as disruptions.
