Erasing Tough Times?

A gentleman named Jonathan Haidt once developed a great exercise that challenges our attitude and approach toward adversity. In this exercise, he said to imagine that you could read the entire script of your children's lives before they were born.

Each script would reveal everything your children would go through in their lives. You could have access to each script for ten minutes along with an eraser so that you could edit it and remove whatever you didn't want your children to experience.

You read in the script that your son would have a learning disability. Reading would be extremely difficult and frustrating for him. Would you erase this experience so that he could avoid it?

All throughout high school, your daughter dreams of going to a certain university. It's all that she talks about for years but her test scores aren't high enough to get in. She's crushed. Would you allow your daughter to go through that pain?

Your son would get a great job with a Fortune 500 company but after two years he would be laid off unexpectedly because of cutbacks. He would lose his house and have to move into a small apartment to make ends meet. Would you leave that in?

So what would you erase? Would you take out all of the painful experiences? Would you choose to erase every failure and setback or just some of them? Do you believe that by being exempt from tough times your children would grow up to be better, stronger, or more generous people? It's interesting to think about. A guy by the name of James who faced his share of tough times once wrote:

"Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking in anything". - (James 1:1-2)

I cannot honestly say that I look forward to tough times, who does? However, these words from James help me to keep them in proper perspective. May God grant us His strength, not just to endure trials, but also to grow stronger in our faith because of them.
